We have also worked with ICBC to arrive at a consensus on items for Vintage Accessories and also Safety upgrades.

We will continue to work with ICBC and the different government agencies to keep what we already have and to possibly expand the Collector plate program.

We request your support with your membership. The \$10 you spend on joining the SVABC will go a long way in our continuing negotiations with the above.
