We need leaders for the following May Tour 2015 committees. If you wish to volunteer or have questions, please come to our meeting on September 18, 2013. You may also contact Jack Woolard (jwoolard@telus.net) or Ray Lamb (lambsend@telus.net) or ph 604-857-5018).

Chairmen needed for these committees:

- 1. Entertainment** - Responsible for organizing the Friday, Saturday, and Sunday Social Events. This will include arranging for music, entertainment, guest speakers, head table and co ordinating the oval evening programs.

2. **Venue Decorations** – Responsible for decorating and theme at venue (Ag-Rec Centre) including table centerpieces.
3. **Door Prizes/Chinese Auction, etc.** - Will collect and assist in the distribution of Door Prizes for each of the evening events and for the drawing of winners of the Chinese Auction prizes at the Sunday Banquet.
4. **Promotion** – Responsible for all Tour promotion. Includes to all VCCC members, chapters, media including local papers, radio, TV stations, etc. Secure a Declaration from the Mayor of the Tour dates being “Vintage Car Weekend”. Contact local MLA s , other dignitaries, etc.
5. **Judging** - Responsible to arrange all aspects of vehicle judging for the chief judge. Location of judging, judges breakfast, trophy collection from storage to banquet location and return to storage afterwards. Checking for damaged goods.

8. **Valve Cover Races** - Responsible for organizing transport of valve cover race equipment to and from the venue, planning the valve cover competition and recording of race results (in accordance with VCCC valve cover race rules).
9. **Driving Tour Committee Co-Chairman** – Responsible for planning the western half of the Saturday/Sunday Tours (Leroy Clingwall has volunteered to do the eastern tour) .Also to help with planning of Friday Garage Tours.
