Collector Vehicles Used on Movie Sets

For those of you who use your collector vehicle in movie sets please read the following article very carefully, as you may not be properly insured. ICBC's collector rate class is meant to be used strictly for **pleasure purposes only**, and since you are getting remunerated for the use of your vehicles in the movies, this is no longer deemed pleasure use in the eyes of ICBC.

Here are the three possible scenarios that could happen to you:

If the vehicle is licensed and insured with **valid collector plates**, then the agent must issue the client a manual TOP (APV16/MV1800) and a temporary Change Endorsement (APV40) amending the class rate to U-drive.

If the vehicle being used on a film set is insured under a **Collector Multi Vehicle policy**, then the client would be required to purchase a regular online TOP (APV16L), charging both licence fees and insurance premium for the number of days the TOP is required.

Finally, if the vehicle being used on film set is an **unrenewed or stored Collector-approved vehicle**, then the client would be required to purchase a regular online TOP (APV 16L) charging both licence fees and insurance premium for the number of days the TOP is required.
