## Minutes of the General Meeting held June 4, 2014 for the Central Fraser Valley Chapter of the Vintage Car Club of Canada.

It had been up on blocks in the garage from 1951 up until last year when he and family members cleaned it all up and rolled it out of the garage. George says it's a great project car and he's not sure how far he wants to take it but for now it runs great and the interior has been fixed and it needs new door panels. It is the first production car with compression brakes.
