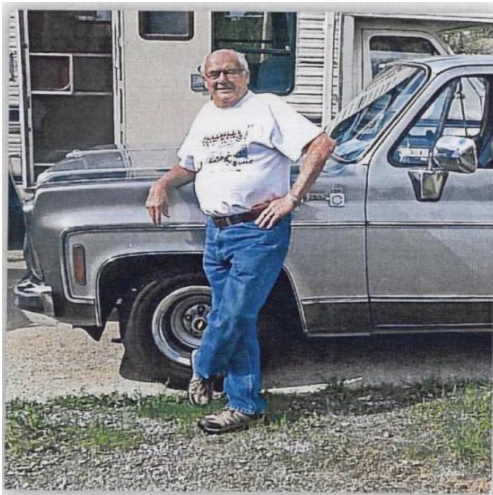
## Internet
