FROM LOIS WILSON

Some of us know members who have passed away or are being treated for kidney disease and may be interested in attending the Summit. One item for discussion will be the presumed consent issue and you may want to express your opinion about changing the legislation so that you will automatically become an organ donor if you should suffer a traumatic brain death during an accident of some kind.

Kidney Transplant Summit - May 1st, 2015

YOU ARE INVITED - NO CHARGE

We know that 95% of British Columbians agree that the Organ Donor Registry is a great idea and yet only 12% actually sign up. The Kidney Foundation, through Community Conversations held throughout the province in 2014 is trying to determine what keeps people from signing up on the Registry and what can be done to overcome these problems.

Our goal is to increase the number of kidney transplants by 50% in the next five years. Here is your chance to lend your voice, ask your questions to the experts and get a head start on the direction the Kidney Foundation will be taking over the next five years to help kidney patients surviving on dialysis.

The Kidney Transplant Summit will be held Friday, May 1st between 11:00 and 4:30 at the Vancouver Trade and Convention Centre. It is free and a bag lunch and refreshments will be provided. Parking is free.

The event will open with a Special Patient Forum which will honour and celebrate kidney patients and their families, their struggles and triumphs. Following the Patient Forum, the Kidney Transplant Summit will examine controversial questions related to kidney transplantation and organ donor registration. It will be set like a courtroom and a Jury Panel will be present to hear expert presentations both for and against several controversial questions and then deliberate in order to decide if they can reach a consensus. For example, one question is likely to be on whether the BC government should adopt "presumed consent" legislation which requires people to opt out of being a deceased organ donor rather than our current opt-in approach. The Jury will hear 10 minute presentations from leading experts on both approaches, have the opportunity to ask questions and then deliberate in private as they try to reach consensus in favour or against.

At the end of the event, results of the Summit recommendations will be released to the media. These recommendations will guide our advocacy efforts throughout the five year Campaign.
